



**Longview Devils Elbow Adelaide Hills Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 ★★★★★**

Rich, full-bodied wine - still youthful and needing more cellaring time. Some complexity developing. Has a solid tannin base well integrated with the ripe varietal fruit. \$27

**Mildara Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 ★★★★★**

Good depth of attractive perfumed aromas - quite mature. Chocolatey palate has life, richness and weight with an attractive fleshy texture. \$29.99

**Malone Wrattenbully Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 ★★★★★**

"A porty brute," according to one judge. Nice concentration of ripe varietal fruit characters. Rich without being overly sweet. \$25

**Possums Vineyard McLaren Vale Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 ★★1/2**

Sound, chocolatey Bordeaux style with the attractive varietal fruit nicely balanced by some drying oak. \$25

**Palmer Margaret River Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 ★★1/2**

Tarry/cherry aromas with underlying fruit and a bright, medium-bodied palate with good length of varietal fruit. \$27.50

**Angas Plains Estate PJ's Langhorne Creek Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 ★★1/2**

Fragrant herbaceous/oaky nose and a rich, ripe and generous palate showing some alcohol heat. \$25



**Angas Plains Estate PJ's Langhorne Creek Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 ★★1/2**

Subdued earthy/toasty bouquet with spicy notes. Palate structurally great - generous and round with good wood. \$25

**Kies Chaff Mill Barossa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 ★★**

Good wine from a tough year. Nice rustic characters and fleshy texture. \$25

Lots of solid wines, with most on the leaner side and a few overripe and flat numbers. Many will change in the next few years but it is debatable whether this will equate to improvement. "These are drinking remarkably well but without excitement."

**Bird in Hand Adelaide Hills Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 ★★1/2**

Classic dark coffeeberry aromas with a slight leafy green edge, and a very varietal Christmas pudding of a palate with persistent flavours and decent oak integration. \$35



**B3 Wines Pauline Barossa Cabernet Shiraz 2008 ★★★★★**

Solid wine not giving much away at the moment, but it's all there - it just needs time. Some lovely varietal fruit with well-matched oak. \$39

**Angas Plains Special Reserve Langhorne Creek Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 ★★★★★**

Some classic oak on a cassis nose with a touch of earthiness. Big, rich, flavoursome, fruit-laden palate with a long, sweet finish. \$36.95

**Taylor's St Andrews Clare Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2006 ★★★★★**

Warm, generous and well-balanced wine that's ageing very nicely. Some lovely honest, sweet varietal fruit. Very good cabernet. \$35

**Yalumba FDR1A Barossa Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz 2008 ★★1/2**

Attractive, juicy varietal with pleasing jubeey sweet fruit on a full-bodied palate showing a decent flavour length. \$39.95

**Fraser Gallop Estate Estate Grown Margaret River Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 ★★1/2**

Quite a rich, full-bodied wine with a strong tannic backbone and lovely pure varietal fruit expression. \$37

**Pertaringa Rifle & Hunt Adelaide Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 ★★1/2**

Concentrated colour with pure varietal fruit and the oak sitting nicely. Some decent tannins evident. Sweet on the finish. \$39

**Sticks No.29 Yea Valley Cabernet Shiraz 2007 ★★**

Attractive minty aromas and a palate full of fruit with nice layers of tannins. \$35

**Salena Estate Founders' Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 ★★**

Shy, slightly spicy, nose and a palate that has a good hit of flavour and shows some depth. \$39.99



**Hardys HRB/D636 Coonawarra Margaret River Cabernet Sauvignon 2006 ★★**

Solid, ripe sweet fruit with decent oak and the tannins sitting on top. \$39



**Houghton Wisdom Margaret River Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 ★★**

Crimson wine with juicy, rich cabernet fruit, lovely firm tannins and some nice oak. \$35
